LIFESAVING TECHNOLOGY NOW INSTALLED

A portable defibrillator is now located in the church office in case of emergency. According to the American Red Cross, "Sudden cardiac arrest is among the leading causes of death in the United States. In fact, more than 350,000 people will suffer a cardiac arrest this year. Currently, the only way to restore a regular heart rhythm during cardiac arrest is to use an AED (or automated external defibrillator)." In the event of a cardiac emergency at church, first responders will administer CPR while others can call 911 and retrieve the AED from the office. Take a look inside the office to familiarize yourself with where the AED is located.
